That phrase was written long time ago.


Being an actress for many years in the Theater and TV, it is not surprising that my sculpturing works are influenced and inspired by the images and characters presented within this media.


Drama, Color, Emotions, and Expressions – it is all there.

Clay, Wood, Iron and other materials are involved in my vision and work.









Detail from Salmon Fall.





Family. Wood Iron net Linen Stones Shamotte Clay 0.5 transparent Glaze and Gold. 150x160x130 cm


